

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

**MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY ('MTR')
WEST ISLAND LINE**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
SECTIONS OF HILL ROAD, SOUTH LANE, HIGH STREET, BONHAM ROAD,
QUEEN'S ROAD WEST AND TSZ MI ALLEY, AND
A FOOTPATH ADJACENT TO SAI WOO LANE PLAYGROUND**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 4 March 2014 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of a section of Hill Road between its junction with Po Tuck Street and a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Queen's Road West, and a section of South Lane adjacent to Hill Road Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow and red respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G03/0006/3;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of a section of High Street between its junction with Eastern Street and a point about 150 metres east of the junction, a section of Bonham Road between its junction with Park Road and a point about 90 metres west of its junction with High Street, and a section of Queen's Road West between Eastern Street and Sutherland Street, as delineated and shown in orange, brown and pink respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/4 ; and
- (III) the temporary closure of a section of Tsz Mi Alley between its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 20 metres north of the junction, and a footpath adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground between its junction with Tsz Mi Alley and a point about 10 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and green respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/4,

during the period from 31 March to 31 December 2014 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR West Island Line. A description of the works to be carried out, the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered WIL/G03/0006/3 and WIL/G05/0006/4 ('the Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads affected by the Order on 14 March 2014.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

<i>The roads to be affected</i>	<i>Description of the works and the manner in which the roads will be affected</i>
(a) A section of Hill Road between its junction with Po Tuck Street and a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Queen's Road West, and a section of South Lane adjacent to Hill Road Rest Garden, as delineated and shown in yellow and red respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G03/0006/3.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong, the associated railway facilities and related reinstatement works of the MTR West Island Line.
(b) A section of High Street between its junction with Eastern Street and a point about 150 metres east of the junction, and a section of Bonham Road between its junction with Park Road and a point about 90 metres west of its junction with High Street, as delineated and shown in orange and brown respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/4.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.
(c) A section of Queen's Road West between Eastern Street and Sutherland Street, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/4.	Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway passenger adit to the railway station at Sai Ying Pun, the associated railway facilities and related reinstatement works of the MTR West Island Line.
(d) A section of Tsz Mi Alley between its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 20 metres north of the junction, and a footpath adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground between its junction with Tsz Mi Alley and a point about 10 metres east of the junction as delineated and shown in blue and green respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/4.	The footpaths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun, the associated railway facilities related and reinstatement works of the MTR West Island Line.

Statement on Personal Data
