

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Notice under section 23)**

**MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY ('MTR')
WEST ISLAND LINE**

**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LI SING STREET, SECTIONS OF
SUTHERLAND STREET, DES VOEUX ROAD WEST AND KO SHING STREET;
AND FOOTPATH BETWEEN WILMER STREET AND LI SING STREET**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 20 May 2013 (the 'Order'), authorized:-

- (I) the temporary partial closure of Li Sing Street, and section of Sutherland Street between Des Voeux Road West and Ko Shing Street, as delineated and shown in orange and light blue respectively on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of the section of Des Voeux Road West between Sai Woo Lane and Connaught Road West, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the sections of Ko Shing Street between Des Voeux Road West and Li Sing Street and between Li Sing Street and Queen Street, as delineated and shown in dark blue and yellow respectively on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2; and
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of the footpath between Wilmer Street and Li Sing Street, as delineated and shown in grey on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2,

during the period from 25 June 2013 to 24 June 2014 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR West Island Line. A description of the works to be carried out and the areas of the roads and the footpath to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2 (the 'Plans') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads and the footpath affected by the Order on 7 June 2013.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the roads and the footpath or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the roads and the footpath affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure of the same part or parts of the roads and the footpath or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

The roads and the footpath to be affected *Description of the works and the manner in which the roads and the footpath will be affected*

- (a) Li Sing Street, and the section of Sutherland Street between Des Voeux Road West and Ko Shing Street, as delineated and shown in orange and light blue respectively on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2. Parts of carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnels of the MTR West Island Line.
- (b) The section of Des Voeux Road West between Sai Woo Lane and Connaught Road West, as delineated and shown in green on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2. Parts of carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnels of the MTR West Island Line.
- (c) The section of Ko Shing Street between Des Voeux Road West and Li Sing Street, as delineated and shown in dark blue on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2. The carriageways and parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnels of the MTR West Island Line.
- (d) The section of Ko Shing Street between Li Sing Street and Queen Street, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2. Parts of carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnels of the MTR West Island Line.
- (e) The footpath between Wilmer Street (near Kam Chuen Building) and Li Sing Street (near Luen Wah Building), as delineated and shown in grey on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0007/2 and WIL/G06/0007/2. Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the railway tunnels of the MTR West Island Line.

Statement on Personal Data

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 34 of the Railways Ordinance is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters.
