**AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
THE OPEN SPACES IN MUI FONG STREET CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND
AND CENTRE STREET SITTING-OUT AREA, PART OF THE OPEN SPACE IN
KING GEORGE V MEMORIAL PARK, HONG KONG, AND
SECTIONS OF CENTRE STREET, EASTERN STREET,
HIGH STREET, FIRST STREET AND SECOND STREET**

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:—

- (I) the temporary closure of the open spaces in Mui Fong Street Children's Playground and Centre Street Sitting-out Area, as delineated and shown in light blue and pink respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0008/3;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of part of the open space in King George V Memorial Park, Hong Kong, as delineated and shown in grey on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0008/3;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of the section of Centre Street between First Street and Second Street, section of Eastern Street between High Street and Bonham Road, section of High Street between its junction with Eastern Street and a point about 60 metres west of the junction and section of High Street between a point about 75 metres west of its junction with Eastern Street and a point about 10 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, as delineated and shown in yellow, brown and red respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0008/3; and
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of the section of First Street between Centre Street and a point about 130 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, and section of Second Street between Centre Street and a point about 130 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, as delineated and shown in green and orange respectively on the Plans numbered WIL/G05/0008/3 and WIL/G08/0008/2,

during the period from 6 August 2013 to 5 August 2014. I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that during the period from 6 August 2013 to 5 August 2014, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the open spaces and the sections of the roads as described above shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
