**NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING
PERMANENT CLOSURE OF
PARTS OF THE OPEN SPACE IN SAI WOO LANE PLAYGROUND,
SECTIONS OF TSZ MI ALLEY AND
A FOOTPATH ADJACENT TO SAI WOO LANE PLAYGROUND**

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 7 January 2015 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the permanent closure of parts of the open space in Sai Woo Lane Playground, and the section of Tsz Mi Alley adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow and red respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0002/5 with effect from 31 January 2015; and
- (II) the permanent closure of the section of Tsz Mi Alley between a point about 10 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 20 metres north of the junction, and the footpath adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground between its junction with Tsz Mi Alley and a point about 10 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and green respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0002/5 with effect from 1 April 2015;

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR West Island Line. A description of the works to be carried out, the parts of the open space, the sections of the road and the footpath to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0002/5 (the 'Plan') may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the open space, the road and the footpath affected by the Order on 16 January 2015.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure of the relevant part or parts of the open space, the road and the footpath or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the open space, the road and the footpath affected by the Order.

(a) Parts of the open space in Sai Woo Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan.	Parts of the open space will be permanently closed for the opening and operation of the railway station entrances of the MTR West Island Line at Sai Ying Pun.
(b) The section of Tsz Mi Alley adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground, and the section of Tsz Mi Alley between a point about 10 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 20 metres north of the junction, as delineated and shown in red and blue respectively on the Plan.	The footpaths will be permanently closed for the opening and operation of the railway station entrances of the MTR West Island Line at Sai Ying Pun.
(c) The footpath adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground between its junction with Tsz Mi Alley and a point about 10 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan.	The footpath will be permanently closed for the opening and operation of the railway station entrances of the MTR West Island Line at Sai Ying Pun.
