TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE, THE ROAD ADJACENT TO
KI LING LANE CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND AND DES VOEUX ROAD WEST;
AND TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE AND
DES VOEUX ROAD WEST AS VEHICULAR ACCESS

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 2 September 2015 (the 'Order'), authorized:—

- (I) the permanent closure of part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5 with effect from 1 October 2015; and
- (II) (a) the temporary closure of part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5;
 - (b) the temporary partial closure of the section of Ki Ling Lane between a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West, the section of the road adjacent to Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, and the section of Des Voeux Road West between its junctions with Chung Ching Street and Sai Yuen Lane, as delineated and shown in red, blue and pink respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5; and
 - (c) the temporary alteration of the section of Ki Ling Lane between its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, and the section of Des Voeux Road West as vehicular access, as delineated and shown in green and orange respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5,

during the period from 1 October 2015 to 30 September 2016,

for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR West Island Line. A description of the works to be carried out, the areas of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the sections of the roads to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure/alteration of the relevant part or parts of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the roads or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the roads affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure/alteration of the same part or parts of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the roads or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure/alteration will be published if and when such an order is made.

SCHEDULE

Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the roads to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground and the roads will be affected

(a) Part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, as delineated and shown in purple on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5. Part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground will be permanently closed for the opening and operation of the railway station entrance and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

(b) Part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5. Part of Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.

(c) The section of Ki Ling Lane between a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West, and the section of the road adjacent to Ki Ling Lane Children's Playground, as delineated and shown in red and blue respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5. Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works.

(d) The section of the Des Voeux Road West between its junctions with Chung Ching Street and Sai Yuen Lane, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed to facilitate the reinstatement works

(e) The section of Ki Ling Lane between its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, and the section of Des Voeux Road West, as delineated and shown in green and orange respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/5. Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily altered as vehicular access for the construction of the railway station entrance and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line, and the reinstatement works
