

**RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Order under section 22(1))**

**MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY ('MTR')
WEST ISLAND LINE**

**AUTHORIZATION FOR TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
THE OPEN SPACE IN KI LING LANE PLAYGROUND; AND
SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE,
THE ROAD ADJACENT TO KI LING LANE PLAYGROUND,
DES VOEUX ROAD WEST AND QUEEN'S ROAD WEST; AND
TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE AND
DES VOEUX ROAD WEST AS VEHICULAR ACCESS**

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:—

- (I) the temporary closure of the open space in Ki Ling Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/4;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of a section of Ki Ling Lane between a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West, and a section of the road adjacent to Ki Ling Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in red and blue respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/4;
- (III) the temporary partial closure of a section of Des Voeux Road West between a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Western Street and a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, and a section of Queen's Road West between Ki Ling Lane and a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, as delineated and shown in pink and brown respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/4; and
- (IV) the temporary alteration of a section of Ki Ling Lane between its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, and a section of Des Voeux Road West as vehicular access, as delineated and shown in green and orange respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/4,

during the period from 1 January to 30 September 2015. I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that during the period from 1 January to 30 September 2015 all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the roads and the open space as described above shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
