

RAILWAYS ORDINANCE (Chapter 519)
(Order under section 22(1))

MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY ('MTR')
WEST ISLAND LINE

AUTHORIZATION FOR
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF
HIGH STREET, BONHAM ROAD, QUEEN'S ROAD WEST AND TSZ MI ALLEY,
AND A FOOTPATH ADJACENT TO SAI WOO LANE PLAYGROUND

In exercise of the powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing, I, by this order made under section 22(1)(a) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), authorize:—

- (I) the temporary partial closure of a section of Bonham Road between its junction with Park Road and a point about 90 metres west of its junction with High Street, and a section of Queen's Road West between a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Eastern Street and its junction with Sutherland Street, as delineated and shown in brown and pink respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/5 during the period from 1 January to 31 March 2015;
- (II) the temporary closure of a section of Tsz Mi Alley between its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 20 metres north of the junction, and a footpath adjacent to Sai Woo Lane Playground between its junction with Tsz Mi Alley and a point about 10 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and green respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/5 during the period from 1 January to 31 March 2015; and
- (III) the temporary partial closure of a section of High Street between its junction with Eastern Street and a point about 110 metres east of the junction, as delineated and shown in orange on the Plan numbered WIL/G05/0006/5 during the period from 1 January to 30 September 2015.

I further declare under section 22(1)(c) that all public or private rights in, upon, under or over (i) the sections of roads and footpaths as described in (I) and (II) above during the period from 1 January to 31 March 2015; and (ii) the section of the road as described in (III) above during the period from 1 January to 30 September 2015 shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be.
