NOTICE OF ORDER AUTHORIZING

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF ROCK HILL STREET,
NORTH STREET, SANDS STREET AND POK FU LAM ROAD;
A PART OF THE FOOTBRIDGE AT THE SOUTH OF POK FU LAM ROAD;
A FOOTPATH NEAR THE BELCHER'S;
SECTIONS OF QUEEN'S ROAD WEST, WHITTY STREET, BELCHER'S STREET,
COLLINSON STREET, PRAYA, KENNEDY TOWN AND SHING SAI ROAD;
A PART OF THE WESTERN DISTRICT PUBLIC CARGO WORKING AREA;
THE OPEN SPACE IN KI LING LANE PLAYGROUND; AND
SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE, THE ROAD ADJACENT TO KI LING LANE
PLAYGROUND AND DES VOEUX ROAD WEST; AND
TEMPORARY ALTERATION OF SECTIONS OF KI LING LANE AND
DES VOEUX ROAD WEST AS VEHICULAR ACCESS

Notice is hereby given that under section 22(1) of the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519), the Deputy Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has, by order made on 5 February 2013 (the 'Order'), authorized –

- (I) the temporary partial closure of Rock Hill Street, a section of North Street between Belcher's Street and Rock Hill Street, and a section of Sands Street between Belcher's Street and Academic Terrace;
- (II) the temporary partial closure of a section of Pok Fu Lam Road between a point near the Pok Fu Lam Zone Substation and a point about 20 metres south-west of Pao Siu Loong Building of the University of Hong Kong, and a part of the footbridge near Haking Wong Building of the University of Hong Kong and at the south of Pok Fu Lam Road;
- (III) the temporary closure of a footpath between its junction with Pok Fu Lam Road and a point near The Belcher's;
- (IV) the temporary partial closure of a section of Queen's Road West between a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Whitty Street and a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Whitty Street, and a section of Whitty Street between its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 35 metres north of the junction;

- (V) the temporary partial closure of a section of Belcher's Street between a point about 45 metres south of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 70 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street, and sections of Collinson Street:
- (VI) the temporary partial closure of a section of Praya, Kennedy Town between a point about 80 metres south-west of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 70 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street, a section of Shing Sai Road between a point about 110 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street North and a point about 80 metres north-east of its junction with Sands Street, and a part of the Western District Public Cargo Working Area;
- (VII) the temporary closure of the open space in Ki Ling Lane Playground;
- (VIII) the temporary partial closure of a section of Ki Ling Lane between a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West, and a section of the road adjacent to Ki Ling Lane Playground;
- (IX) the temporary partial closure of a section of Des Voeux Road West between a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Western Street and a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, and sections of Queen's Road West between Ki Ling Lane and a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Centre Street; and
- (X) the temporary alteration of a section of Ki Ling Lane between its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 15 metres south of the junction, and a section of Des Voeux Road West as vehicular access,

during the period from 12 March 2013 to 11 March 2014 for the purposes of or incidental to the railway scheme of the MTR West Island Line. A description of the works to be carried out and the areas of the roads, the cargo working area and the open space to be affected and the manner in which they will be affected is given in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Plan numbered WIL/G02/0005/2 delineating and showing the sections of the roads affected by (I) in yellow, blue and green respectively; the Plan numbered WIL/G03/0005/2 delineating and showing the sections of the roads affected by (II) and (III) in yellow, blue and green respectively; the Plan numbered WIL/G04/0005/2 delineating and showing the sections of the roads affected by (IV) in blue and purple respectively; the Plan numbered WIL/G07/0005/2 delineating and showing the sections of the roads and part of the cargo working area affected by (V) and (VI) in green, red, blue, brown and pink respectively; and the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/2 delineating and showing the open space and sections of the roads affected by (VII), (VIII), (IX) and (X) in yellow, red, blue, pink, brown, green and orange respectively may be inspected by the public free of charge at the following places and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:-

A copy of this notice will be affixed on or near the roads, the cargo working area and the open space affected by the Order on 22 February 2013.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Railways Ordinance (Chapter 519) may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing on 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong so as to reach the Secretary before the expiration of one year from the closure or alteration of the relevant part or parts of the roads, the cargo working area and the open space or the extinction, modification or restriction of his private right in respect of the relevant part or parts of the road, the cargo working area and the open space affected by the Order.

Notice is hereby given that further closure and/or alteration of the same part or parts of the roads, the cargo working area and the open space or any of such part or parts may be required upon expiration of the Order. Details of any further order for closure and/or alteration will be published if and when such an order is made.

## **SCHEDULE**

The roads, the cargo working area and the open space to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the cargo working area and the open space will be affected

(a) Rock Hill Street and a section of North Street between Belcher's Street and Rock Hill Street, as delineated and shown in yellow and blue respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G02/0005/2. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station at Kennedy Town and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line

(b) A section of Sands Street between Belcher's Street and Academic Terrace, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered WIL/G02/0005/2. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths (including the staircase) will be temporarily closed for the construction of the pedestrian footbridge link at Sands Street and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line

(c) A section of Pok Fu Lam Road between a point near the Pok Fu Lam Zone Substation and a point about 20 metres south-west of the Pao Siu Loong Building of the University of Hong Kong, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered WII/G03/0005/2. Part of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

(d) A part of the footbridge near Haking Wong Building of the University of Hong Kong and at the south of Pok Fu Lam Road, as delineated and shown in blue on the Plan numbered WIL/G03/0005/2. Parts of the footbridge will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

(e) A footpath between its junction with Pok Fu Lam Road and a point near The Belcher's, as delineated and shown in green on the Plan numbered WIL/G03/0005/2. The footpath will be temporarily closed for the construction of station entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line The roads, the cargo working area and the open space to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the cargo working area and the open space will be affected

(f) A section of Queen's Road West between a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Whitty Street and a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Whitty Street; and a section of Whitty Street between its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 35 metres north of the junction, as delineated and shown in blue and purple respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G04/0005/2. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

(g) A section of Belcher's Street between a point about 45 metres south of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 70 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street and a section of Collinson Street, as delineated and shown in green and red respectively on the Plan numbered WII./G07/0005/2. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station near the University of Hong Kong and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

(h) A section of Praya, Kennedy Town between a point about 80 metres south-west of its junction with Queen's Road West and a point about 70 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street; and a section of Shing Sai Road between a point about 110 metres north-east of its junction with Sai Cheung Street North and a point about 80 metres north-east of its iunction with Sands Street. delineated and shown in blue and brown respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G07/0005/2.

Part of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the temporary overhead conveyance system and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

 A part of the Western District Public Cargo Working Area, as delineated and shown in pink on the Plan numbered WIL/G07/0005/2. Parts of the lorry parking area will be temporarily closed for the construction of the temporary overhead conveyance system and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line. The roads, the cargo working area and the open space to be affected

Description of the works and the manner in which the roads, the cargo working area and the open space will be affected

- (j) The open space in Ki Ling Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in yellow on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/2.
- The open space will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.
- (k) A section of Ki Ling Lane between a point about 15 metres south of its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 20 metres north of its junction with Queen's Road West and a section of the road adjacent to Ki Ling Lane Playground, as delineated and shown in red and blue respectively on the Plan numbered WII /G08/0005/2.

Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line

(1) A section of the Des Voeux Road West between a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Western Street and a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Centre Street; and a section of Queen's Road West between Ki Ling Lane and a point about 60 metres west of its junction with Centre Street, as delineated and shown in pink and brown respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/2. Parts of the carriageway and footpath widths will be temporarily closed for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line

(m) A section of Ki Ling Lane between its junction with Des Voeux Road West and a point about 15 metres south of the junction and a section of Des Voeux Road West, as delineated and shown in green and orange respectively on the Plan numbered WIL/G08/0005/2. Parts of the footpath widths will be temporarily altered as vehicular access for the construction of the station entrance of the railway station at Sai Ying Pun and the associated railway facilities of the MTR West Island Line.

## Statement on Personal Data
